

St. Mary and St. Peter Youth Ministry and PREP 2017-2018 Permission Slip, Emergency Medical Form, and Registration Form

This form is the permission slip/emergency medical form for all youth ministry and religious education programs and events in the 2017-2018 school year, and the registration form for PREP and Sunday Youth Ministry. The emergency medical form is on the second page. The registration form for PREP and Sunday Youth Ministry is on the third. Please completely fill out a separate Permission Slip, Emergency Medical Form, and Registration Form for each child in your family. Emergency medical information will be kept on file for all activities this year.

Any youth over 18 but less than three months out of high school may participate in Sunday Youth Ministry and youth ministry events, but must fill out a different form upon turning 18.

Children or youth who wish to participate in one or more youth ministry events this year, but do not regularly attend PREP or Sunday Youth Ministry, may fill out a different form, or simply fill out the first two pages of this form; the third page (PREP and Sunday Youth Ministry Registration) is not necessary in this case.

Permission, Release, and Medical Power of Attorney

1. I, the lawful parent or guardian of _____ (the "child"), give permission for my child to participate in all St. Mary and St. Peter youth ministry and religious education activities from April 30, 2017 through to September 30, 2018 described in the "Activity Information" section below and release from all liability and indemnify the Archdiocese of Cincinnati (the "Archdiocese"), the Archbishop of Cincinnati ("the Archbishop"), both individually and as trustee for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, and all parishes and schools within the Archdiocese, and their respective officers, agents, representatives, volunteers, and employees from any and all liability, claims, judgments, cost and expenses, including attorneys' fees, arising out of any injury or illness incurred by my child while participating in or traveling to or from the activities and further agree not to bring or prosecute or allow to be brought or prosecuted (including but not limited to prosecution through subrogation) in my name, or on behalf of my child, any claims, lawsuits or actions against the Archbishop, the Archdiocese, and their respective officers, agents, representatives, volunteers and employees.
2. I agree to instruct my child to cooperate with the Archbishop or his agents in charge of the activity.
3. I appoint the Archbishop or his agents who are acting as leaders of the activities as my attorney in fact to act for me in my name and my behalf, in any way that I would act if I were personally present, with respect to the following matters if any injury, illness or medical emergency occurs during the activities:
 - a. To give any and all consents and authorizations to any physician, dentist, hospital or other persons or institutions pertaining to any emergency medications, medical or dental treatments, diagnostic or surgical procedures or any other emergency actions as our attorney shall deem necessary or appropriate for the best interest of the child.
 - b. I understand that the agents of the Archbishop will make a reasonable attempt to contact me as soon as possible in the event of a medical emergency involving my child. If such contact is made, and I wish to give a directive regarding the medical treatment of my child, the Archbishop or his agents in charge of the activity, as my attorney, will follow such a directive; if I, knowingly or unknowingly, give no directives concerning one or more aspects of my child's medical treatment, my attorney will make prudential decisions as to what to do regarding these aspects, as described in section 3.a., above.
 - c. This power of attorney shall lapse automatically upon completion of the activity and related travel.
4. I agree that the Archbishop or his agents may use a photograph, video or other likeness of my child for promotional purposes, website and office functions and use social media and technology to communicate to my child regarding ministry related activities.

Medications

Children may administer their own medications. Medications will be turned in to a designated adult leader (unless this is impractical), who will store it and make it available when the child needs it.

If it is necessary for an adult leader to administer prescribed medication, the medication must be in its original container, with the label/directives from the pharmacy still intact. Parents/Guardians must indicate below the name of the medication to be administered, give consent for an adult leader to administer the medication, and may also give any additional directives besides those written on the label.

Over the counter medication may be administered by adult leaders with the written consent of the child's parent/guardian.

2017-2018 PREP and Sunday Youth Ministry Registration

If you would like to register your child for PREP (Parish Religious Education Program) or Sunday Youth Ministry, please completely fill out the form below, and return it, along with your family's fee (if applicable) and the rest of this *Permission Slip, Emergency Medical Form, and Registration Form* to PJ Ehling. **The deadline to register for PREP and Sunday Youth Ministry is August 13, 2017.** Please register for PREP and Sunday Youth Ministry by August 13 so that your parish can have an accurate enrollment of students, we can order the right amount of textbooks, catechists can prepare accordingly, and to help PJ plan for sacramental preparation.

PREP and Sunday Youth Ministry compose the religious education program for all children in our parishes, from preschool to 12th grade. At St. Mary, PREP serves kids in grades PK-6. At St. Peter, PREP serves kids in PK-8. At both parishes, Sunday Youth Ministry serves youth in grades 7-12.

Confirmation preparation will not be offered at either parish this year, since we had Confirmation preparation last year. We usually offer Confirmation preparation every other year due to small class sizes.

Other youth ministry events (such as the K-6 youth nights and 7-12 youth ministry outings) are not included in this registration. Some have their own registration processes, while some do not have any registration process at all. Please see the youth ministry bulletin board at your parish for more information regarding these events.

Both St. Mary's and St. Peter's PREP programs meet almost every Sunday, and Sunday Youth Ministry alternates locations and times on Sundays through the school year, as described in each parish's *PREP and Youth Ministry Schedule*. If you do not have a copy of this document, contact PJ Ehling to obtain one.

- **St. Mary's PK-6th graders** meet Sunday mornings, from 9:00-10:15am.
- **St. Peter's PK-8th graders** meet Sunday mornings from 9:30-10:45am.
- **Sunday Youth Ministry** meets on Sundays at St. Mary from 11:30am-1:30pm, and at St. Peter from 12:00-2:00pm.

Both PREP programs charge a fee. There is no fee for youth in Sunday Youth Ministry, because we do not use a textbook. The PREP fee is per family, not per student. For 2017-2018, the fees are as follows:

- \$15.00 for a family with one child in PREP
 - \$25.00 for a family with two children in PREP
 - \$30.00 for a family with three or more children in PREP
- *If your family is unable to pay for part or all of the PREP fee, please contact PJ Ehling.
**The PREP fee is waived for catechists' families. Thank you for your service to our parishes!
