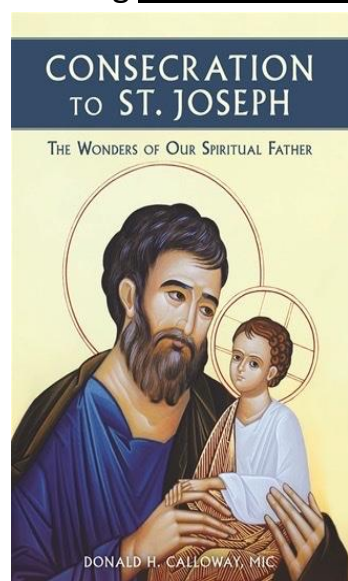


With a Father's Heart – A Consecration to St. Joseph
